	• The pool at Providence Rec Center is 25 yards x 25 meters. 10 lanes are available for warm-ups; 8 lanes will be used for competition. Water depth ranges from 4'-12.5' at both the starting and turning ends.
	• The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules</i> and <i>Regulations</i> , Article 104.2.2(C).

	Meet Director reserves the right to adjust times/sessions after entries are received.
ELIGIBILITY	 Open to all Potomac Valley Swimming registered athletes. No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations Article 302.
	 Swimmers may only participate in their own age group, based upon their age on the first day of the meet.
	• Entries will be processed in the order in which they are received until capacity has been reached.
DISABILITY	PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as
SWIMMERS	adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide
	advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach)
TIMING SYSTEM	is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
COVID-19	 Semi-automatic timing (buttons primary) will be used. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present.
CONSIDERATIONS	COVID-19 is a contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.

- We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for all attending this meet, however we
 cannot guarantee that you will not become infected with COVID-19. All attending this meet must
 follow all posted instructions while in attendance. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19
 exists in any public place where people are present. By attending this meet, you acknowledge the
 contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.
- By choosing to attend this meet you agree to comply with all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Potomac Valley Swimming, the Commonwealth of Virginia, and Fairfax County.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- Before signing up your young swimmer, please consider that they can manage themselves for the duration of the meet with just their swim coach overseeing them, including being able to visit the bathroom independently.
- No more than four hours before entering the facility, all attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) are required to assess their own health for symptoms and exposure to COVID-19.
 Attendees will only be permitted entrance if answering "no" to the following questions:
 - Do you feel any of the symptoms that fall under the symptoms of COVID-19 (fever over 100.4, cough, shortness of breath, etc.)?
 - o Has anyone in your family been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
 - Has someone you've been in contact with been diagnosed with COVID-19 or been in contact with someone who has the past 14 days?
- Athletes must arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use will be for emergency use only,
 no showers may be used. Family bathroom will be reserved for coach, official, and volunteer use.
- All attendees (swimmers, coaches, officials and volunteers) must bring their own water bottle and snacks. Hospitality will not be provided.
- Attendees will enter the facility through the patio doors. From the parking lot, attendees will
 walk down the access road located to the right of the main entrance and proceed through the
 gate to the glass patio doors. Attendees will exit the facility through main facility entrance.
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers) must wear masks to enter the facility and at all times when inside the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming up.
- For the 25 yard events, volunteers will move the baskets containing masks to the finish end of the pool where the swimmers will immediately put them back on after exiting the pool.
- Athletes will bring a plastic zipper bag with their name on it in which to place their masks when they are in the water.
- The meet will be limited to a maximum of 200 swimmers per session.
- A clerk of course will be used to organize each heat of swimmers for all events offered.
- No spectators will be permitted. Competition will be live-streamed by York Swim Club on the York Swim Club Facebook Page.

RULES	 We request that all attendees notify the meet director as quickly as possible should they test positive for COVID-19, show symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed or tested positive for COVID-19 after attending the meet. Any attendee failing or refusing to comply with any of these protocols will be prohibited from entering the facility and/or asked to leave the facility. Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
	No deck entries will be accepted.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	• A swimmer may enter no more than six (6) individual events for the meet, three (3) individual events per session.
AWARDS	• Ribbons will be awarded from 1 st -16 th place for individual events. Special swim caps will be awarded to the winner of each individual heat.
WARM-UP	 The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
PROGRAMS	 Will be emailed to attending teams no later than Friday, December 3, 2021. The meet will be available on Meet Mobile. No programs will be sold at the meet. Programs will be made available for coaches and officials at the meet.
MEET NOTES	Reindeer Mini Meet T-Shirts will be available for purchase in limited quantities.
CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	This meet will have no spectators.
	Competition will be live-streamed on the <u>York Swim Club Facebook Page</u> .

OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.
	 Officials interested in volunteering should fill out the <u>Officials Signup</u> or contact Carolyn Kotarski (<u>ckotarski@gmail.com</u>) directly.
	Officials assigned to this meet should sign in at the recording table 10 minutes before the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.
TIMERS	Two (2) timers per lane.
	• The host club will provide at least 1 timer per lane. Each participating club is requested to provide at least one official and 3 timers if entering 25 or more swimmers.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager by email to the Meet Director.
	• Include in the subject of the email, "Reindeer Mini Meet-***" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. Also include training site if your club submits multiple entry files.
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid by that club.
